older workers can't work from home and are at a higher risk
June 3rd, 2020 - however the bureau of labor statistics also reports that only 25% of older workers can work from home this means nearly three quarters or over 5 million older workers cannot telework and over two

thirds of 55 to 64 year olds cannot telework either this represents another 15 million workers'

May 30th, 2020 - in the united states the vast majority of care that allows older people to live in their own homes is provided by family members who do not receive pay for their services as the older share of the population increases and people live longer with chronic disabling conditions particularly dementia meeting the care needs of older americans will bee more challenging for families'

May 20th, 2020 - older people were not routinely involved in decision making about their needs and preferences older people and their families or carers did not routinely receive clear information about how their health and social care would be coordinated in particular if there were changes in their circumstances or if there was an unplanned or emergency'

June 3rd, 2020 - work is social work with older people g8 members are strongly committed to reinvigorating professional practice and academic interest in social work with older people and their families and to ensuring that this specialist area of social work is defended developed and invested in'
